Lord's Covenant with Abram (15)

Two promises: land and heirs

Hagar and Ishmael (16)

Abram and Sarai grew tired of waiting

Sarai was jealous of the boy

Circumcision (17)

Sign of the covenant

Sarah Promised a Child, Abram pleads for Lot in Sodom (18)
