- ✓ Proclaim good news to the poor
 - > Social ministries: clothing, feeding, etc.
- ✓ Proclaim freedom for the prisoners
 - > Restoration, wholeness
 - Visiting prisoners
 - ➤ Offering grace
 - Counseling
 - > Addiction help
 - > Salvation
- ✓ Recovery of sight for the blind
 - ➤ Healing and health care
 - Spiritual blindness
- ✓ Set the oppressed free
 - Bruised and battered
 - > Spiritually oppressed
- ✓ Proclaim the year of the Lord's favor
 - > Salvation available now

Day-to-Day Responsibilities

Preaching

- ✓ Basics covered in our preaching class
- ✓ Lead people to Jesus and new, eternal life

Teaching

- ✓ Basics covered in our preaching class
- ✓ Teach the Gospel and lead people to Jesus

Pastoral Care

- ✓ Visits
 - ➤ Share the gospel
 - > Don't overstay your welcome

Address purpose of visit

Hear the concerns and needs

Pray

✓ Counseling

> Prayer is crucial for the counselor and the person being counseled

Openness to God's direction

- Focus on listening instead of just hearing
- You don't have to have all the answers

Walk with them to the right resource or solution

You can refer them to a professional

- ✓ Funerals
 - Funeral is an event; grief is a process

Continual care for those grieving

> Circumstances vary; the message does not

Always point to Christ and the hope of the gospel

Any funeral has potential to be a celebration in Christ

- Listening and making time for the family is important
- ✓ Weddings
 - > Recommend pre-marital counseling

Starts with preaching biblical marital values at church

Disciple-making

- ✓ Important to have a process in place for making disciples
 - ➤ Use *Master Plan of Evangelism* by Robert Coleman
 - 1 Selection
 - 2. Association
 - 3. Consecration
 - 4. Impartation
 - 5. Demonstration
 - 6. Delegation
 - 7. Supervision
 - 8. Reproduction
- ✓ It takes time; you cannot rush it
 - > Different for each person

Church Administration

- ✓ Filing reports with your affiliates
 - ➤ Necessary for accountability
- ✓ Planning out the worship service
 - Music and preaching
- ✓ Planning the focus for the church
 - ➤ Having a vision beyond today

Community Leader

- ✓ Be connected in your community
 - > Know your neighbors
 - > Know your community figures
- ✓ Living a life worthy of your calling among non-believers

Conflict-Resolution

- ✓ Method: Matthew 18:15-17
 - > Point: restoration of the person with conflict
 - ➤ Helps avoid triangle problems
- ✓ Focus on listening
 - Many problems can be solved by just listening

Visioning

- ✓ Vision comes from God in prayer and openness
- ✓ Christian conferencing

Team effort, not just the pastor

- ✓ Proverbs 29:18 vision is necessary
- ✓ Steps to Vision:

 - 3. Prayer
